Glasgow City Council is undertaking the next phase of the North Woodside Road consultation. Following on from the consultation held in 2023, we would like to share how your input has helped shape the design for the public space at the junction of North Woodside Road and Great Western Road.

The updated design includes:

- ◆ Introduction of a cycle hire station
- ◆ Improved access with dropped kerbs and tactile paving
- ◆ A rain garden to aid with sustainable drainage and help to support biodiversity
- ◆ Existing footways surrounding the perimeter of the new public space will be resurfaced
- ◆ Proposed amendments to existing local Traffic Regulation Orders

About Connecting Woodside

Connecting Woodside is an area-wide project through Sustrans' Places for Everyone programme funded by Transport Scotland.

We want to work with the community to rebalance streets to reduce the dominance of road traffic and to improve streets and public spaces for people.
