Denominational Education Provision – Carmunnock Area

Background

In October 2010 the Executive Committee of Glasgow City Council approved a consultation on associating the Carmunnock area of the city with schools within the City Council boundary.

How would this be done?

We would associate the Carmunnock area with John Paul II Primary School and St Margaret Mary's Secondary School.

In line with Statutory Law we must discuss this with the people who may be affected by the proposal.

What will we do?

We will consult with people by:-

- Sending a letter and copy of the consultative document to those we believe could be affected by the proposed changes.
- Place an advert in the Evening Times
- Put information on our website.
- Hold public meetings to explain what we want to do.
- Ask parents, carers, children, young people, teachers, support staff and others to tell us what they think of the proposals

Proposals

It is proposed that children and young people who are of school age and live in the Carmunnock area of the city would be zoned to John Paul II Primary School and St Margaret Mary's Secondary School from August 2011 for denominational education.

John Paul II Primary and St Margaret Mary's Secondary Schools are the closest denominational schools managed by Glasgow City Council to the Carmunnock area of the city. Both are big enough for all prospective transfers to be accommodated
